Session Title: How to Identify and Manage Malpractice Risks in Your Role as an Expert Witness

Session Summary: The Program will begin with a survey of malpractice exposure faced by all

valuation professionals in their role as an expert witness. Increasingly, witness immunity fails to protect experts from malpractice and breach of contract claims. Among these malpractice risks are disqualification at a Daubert hearing due to flawed methodology; the arguably greater problem of qualifying as an expert witness only to be subjected to damaging cross-examination; deficient disclosures under expert witness discovery rules; inadvertently breaking the seal of attorney-client privilege; and, conflict of interest. A companion topic would be retaliatory claims by clients when pressured to pay outstanding expert

witness fees. Solutions to these problems will be offered.
